

## ***Money Smart – An Adult Education Program***

The Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation (FDIC) Money Smart Program is a set of 10 instructor-led training modules covering basic financial topics. The subject matter begins with a description of deposit and credit services offered by banks and moves progressively to topics such as choosing and maintaining a checking account, the mechanics of budgeting, the importance of saving, and how to obtain and use credit effectively.
