- First Semi-Annual Reporting Access Dates: March 1 – March 31
- Reporting Due Date: **March 31**
- Reporting Period: August 1, 2015 – January 31, 2016

## Projects with 9/30 start dates

- First Semi-Annual Reporting Access Dates: April 1 – April 30
- Reporting Due Date: **April 30**
- Reporting Period: September 30, 2015 – March 31, 2016

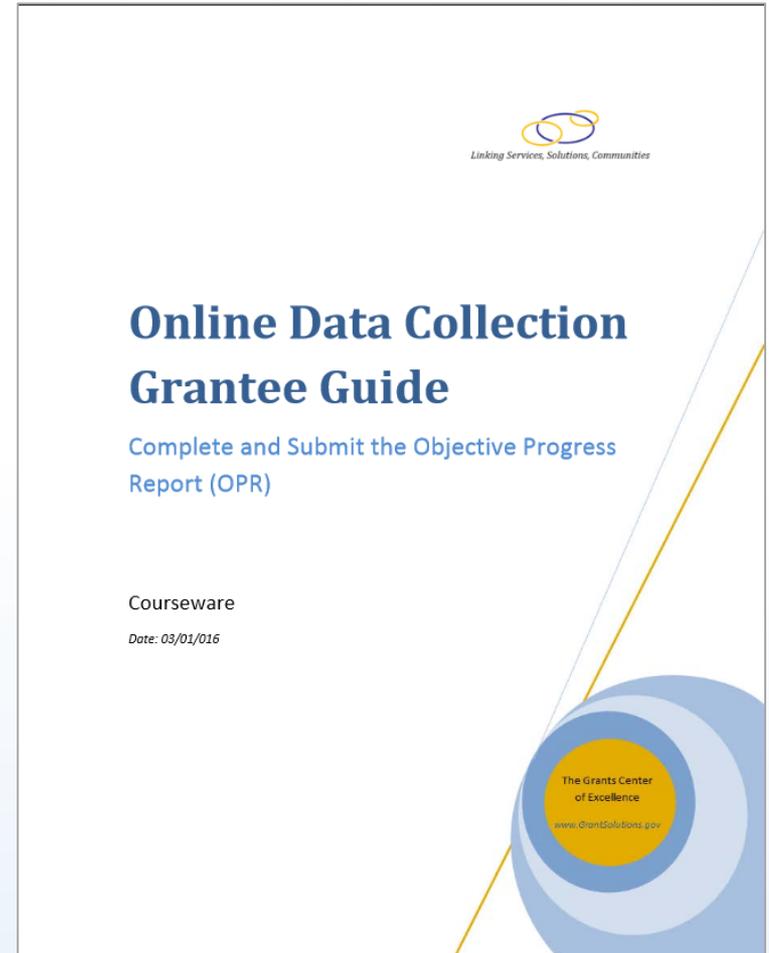
