




DID YOU KNOW? IN 2011:

- The demand for project funding of new awards exceeded \$255 million
- 275 potential applicants attended ANA pre-application training
- ANA administered 200 grants, with an average award amount of \$217,527
- ANA awarded 105 continuation grants, totaling \$24,081,363
- 378 applications were read and scored during the panel review process

Administration for Native Americans Project Funding Fast Facts for 2011


ANA's grant funding is competitive; out of 448 applications received, only 85 grants were awarded, totaling \$17,248,831.

Percent of Applications Awarded




New grants were awarded in 6 program areas, with a distribution representative of applications received.
