Footnote for each table:

All 50 states plus the District of Columbia and Puerto Rico are required to collect and report NYTD data. States were required to collect baseline outcomes information from youth who turned age 17 while in foster care in FFY 2014. At follow-up, states were required to survey youth during the six-month reporting periods in which they turned age 19 (in FFY 16) and 21 (in FFY 18).

Footnote for Employed PT/FT:

*The NYTD survey asks young people two employment questions: (1) whether or not they are currently employed part-time and (2) whether or not they are currently employed full-time. Results in this table indicate the percentages of youth reporting "yes" to at least one of the employment questions.
