

Environmental Regulatory Enhancement (ERE) Program Areas of Interest

Examples of ERE projects include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Provide training and education to employees responsible for enforcing and monitoring compliance with environmental quality laws.
- Develop tribal laws, regulations, and ordinances on environmental quality.
- Enforce and monitoring environmental quality laws, regulations, and ordinances.
- Establish baseline conditions for regulatory purposes.
- Inform the community about regulations and environmental stewardship in order to assist enforcement.
- Build the technical and program capability of the tribe or organization to inform governance, develop tribal laws, and enhance monitoring and enforcement of environmental laws.
- Mitigate environmental impacts to American Indian/Alaska Native lands due to Department of Defense activities.
- Integrate traditional ecological knowledge into program administration to advance historic preservation
- Advance the management and co-management of lands or marine and wildlife
- Address climate change
- Promote environmental justice
