\* All 50 states plus the District of Columbia and Puerto Rico are required to collect and report NYTD data. States were required to collect baseline outcomes information from youth who turned age 17 while in foster care in FFY 2011. At follow-up, states were required to survey youth during the six-month reporting periods in which they turned age 19 (in FFY 13) and 21 (in FFY 15).

\*In FFY2011, youth were asked at age 17 if they had ever been homeless at some point in their lives. In FFYs 2013 and 2015, youth were asked if they had experienced homelessness within the past two years. The NYTD survey questions are in Appendix B of the NYTD regulation, available at:
