<b>Program Goals</b>	(1) Strengthen program infrastructure, curricula and staffing in order to reach an increasing number of families with a consistent schedule of high quality and culturally enriched home visiting services. (2) Foster the development of an effective, well-coordinated and sustainable early childhood system that supports maternal and child health, school readiness and language and cultural learning for San Felipe families. (3) Improve the social, emotional and behavioral health and well-being of caregivers and children in San Felipe Pueblo.

<b>Location of Community</b>	Rural Reservation
<b>Population Served</b>	Pregnant, first time mothers, multiparous mothers, single fathers, parents who live separately and co-parent, or extended family who are the primary caretakers of children residing in San Felipe Pueblo.
<b>Ages of Children Served</b>	Prenatal to up to the child's 3rd birthday
<b>Model</b>	Family Spirit
<b>Other Program Components</b>	(1) Supplement: Utilization of the Circle of Security evidence-based early intervention program designed to enhance secure attachment between parents and children. (2) Supplement: Utilization of a cultural parenting curriculum focused on traditional cultural practices and values associated with raising children in San Felipe Pueblo.

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
