## Grant Goals

- Program Vision** Families nurture their child in ways that honor their traditions and values and incorporate practices for optimal child and family development, health lifestyles, and strong community connections.
- Program Goals** (1) Families with young children will receive high quality services offered through open enrollment and services delivery in the home/natural environment according to each family's expressed needs and availability. (2) Taos Pueblo families participating in the home visiting program will demonstrate development of resilience, social networks, developmentally appropriate guidance, and social-emotional competence that promotes optimal family well-being. (3) Expectant and post-partum mothers, not yet-born, newly born, and young children participating in the home visiting program will demonstrate optimal levels of health and well-being. (4) Tiwa Babies will be the go-to program for early childhood development, linking family prenatal services to Head Start enrollment and supplementing the development of children into their kindergarten year.
