INFORMATION MEMORANDUM

To Tribal Lead Agencies administering child care programs under the Child Care and Development Block Grant (CCDBG) Act of 1990, as amended, and other interested parties.

Subject Fiscal Year (FY) 2011 Child Care and Development Fund (CCDF) Final Allocations and Targeted Funds.

References The Child Care and Development Block Grant (CCDBG) Act of 1990, as amended (42 U.S.C. § 9858 et seq.); section 418 of the Social Security Act as amended (42 U.S.C. § 618); FY 2011 Department of Defense and Full-Year Continuing Appropriations Act (P.L. 112-10); 45 CFR Parts 98 and 99.

Purpose To convey the final FY 2011 Tribal allotments and targeted funds for CCDF.

Background Attached is a table for Tribes showing the final amounts allocated for FY 2011.

Of the total amount of FY 2011 Discretionary Funds awarded, the Full-Year Continuing Appropriations Act (P.L. 112-10) stipulated that a portion be targeted for child care resource and referral and school-aged child care activities. The attached table lists the minimum amount each Tribe must spend for child care resource and referral and school-age child care activities (in the column labeled “Discretionary Targeted Funds School-Age R&R”). Each Tribe’s portion of the Discretionary targeted funds for resource and referral and school-age care activities is based on a \$500 amount per Tribe plus a per child amount.
