SUBJECT:	Form ACF-696T—a Financial Reporting Form for Child Care and Development Fund (CCDF) Tribal Lead Agencies.	
<b>REFERENCES:</b>	The Child Care and Development Block Grant (CCDBG) Act of 1990 as amended; section 418 of the Social Security Act; 45 CFR Parts 98 and 99; the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) of 2009.	
PURPOSE:	This Program Instruction distributes the Form ACF-696T and describes the CCDF financial reporting requirements for Tribal CCDF Lead Agencies. The Office of Management and Budget (OMB) approved the Form ACF-696T under OMB 0970-0195.	
<b>BACKGROUND:</b>	Attached is a copy of the Child Care and Development Fund Financial Report (ACF-696T). Tribes are required to use the ACF-696T to report expenditures for the Tribal Mandatory, Discretionary, and construction and renovation funds issued under CCDF. Tribes are also required to report expenditures for the supplemental Discretionary funds awarded under ARRA in FY 2009. Tribes must submit the ACF-696T form to the Administration for Children and Families (ACF) on an annual basis. Tribal Lead Agencies must submit separate annual reports for each fiscal year in which CCDF funds were awarded. Therefore, a Tribe may be submitting as many as three separate ACF-696T reports this year—one for funds awarded in FY 2009; one for funds awarded in FY 2010; and one for funds awarded in FY 2011. The ACF-696T includes certain data elements that apply <u>only</u> to ARRA funds awarded in FY 2009. These ARRA elements should be left blank on the reports submitted for funds	

awarded in FY 2010 and FY 2011. The ARRA elements include: Column (F) for ARRA Discretionary Funds; Column (G) for ARRA construction and renovation funds; and Line 12 for child service months funded by ARRA.

IMPORTANT: All funds awarded in FY 2009, including ARRA funds, must be reported as liquidated by September 30, 2010; any unliquidated balance must be returned to the Federal Treasury.

ACF-696T is available for submission through the Internet using Online Data Collection (OLDC). Tribal Lead Agencies with OLDC assignments may access the system at: <u>https://extranet.acf.hhs.gov/ssi</u>. Tribal Lead Agencies without OLDC assignments may access the system at the above address after submitting the OLDC Request Form to the appropriate ACF Regional Office contact.

For Tribes that would like to use OLDC but currently lack access, please request access using the OLDC Request Form, which is available (along with OLDC help sheets, user guides, and tutorials) at: https://extranet.acf.hhs.gov/oldcdocs/materials.html. The completed OLDC Request Form may be emailed or faxed to your Regional Office contact (see attached). Please submit an OLDC Request Form for each staff person who will play a role in using OLDC. ACF will create a User Identification (ID) based on the information provided on the OLDC Request Form. An email message is automatically sent to the staff member identified on the Request Form when an OLDC User ID and password is created for that person.

ACTION:Tribal Lead Agencies have the option of submitting their ACF-696T**REQUIRED:**either electronically through OLDC or manually by mailing hard copies.<br/>ACF encourages grantees to use OLDC since it reduces paperwork, allows<br/>for quicker processing, automatically completes required calculations, and<br/>checks for potential errors.

Electronic or manually-submitted forms must be received by ACF within 90 days after the end of the Federal fiscal year (December 29, 2011).
