

4,380 Child Care Programs in North Carolina have Received American Rescue Plan Stabilization Support, Impacting up to 383,100 Children

The ARP Child Care Stabilization program has been an unprecedented lifeline for the child care sector that helped parents return to work and spurred economic recovery. So far, more than 220,000 child care programs serving as many as 9.6 million children have received assistance across the country from this program.

- Providers in 99% of North Carolina counties have received funds.
- 3,180 child care centers that received stabilization payments most commonly used them to pay for personnel costs and keep programs staffed.
- 1,205 child care family homes that received stabilization payments most commonly used them to pay for rent and mortgage payments, typically their largest operating expense.
- On average, child care centers have received an award of \$218,700 and family homes have received \$39,200.
