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## Grant Goals

**Program Vision** To provide holistic, culturally sensitive home visiting services to urban AI/AN children and families living in Maricopa County to support their health, happiness, and success using a high-quality, evidence-based program.

**Program Goals** (1) Implement the Parents as Teachers home visiting model to improve children's school readiness and achievement. (2) Develop and establish methods to engage enrolled families in more culturally responsive services during home visits, in addition to the monthly group connection events. (4) Enable all families enrolled to experience increased safety through decreased child injuries, child abuse, neglect, maltreatment, domestic violence, and reduction of emergency department visits. (4) Provide coordination and referrals to necessary services as needed and identified to enrolled families.
