Program Vision	The Port Gamble S'Klallam community knows TFC as a trusted, safe and supportive resource for families with children under 2 years of age.
Program Goals	(1) Participants improve parenting that fosters children's age-appropriate development. For example, PAT incorporates age appropriate comparisons and activities and a plan to get that child to where he/she should be developmentally as well as keeping the entire family involved in their child's growth and development. (2) Parents form more cohesive connections/bonds with family members and their children. (3) Children will continue to demonstrate strong, age-appropriate development over time.
