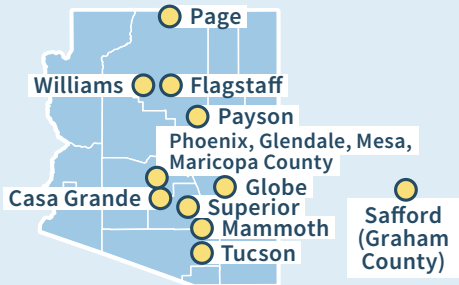


# How to Enroll in Your Local Diaper Distribution Pilot Program

● = communities served by Wildfire



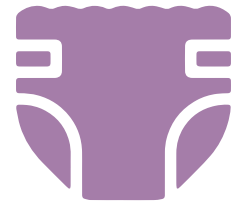

## How can Wildfire help my family?

- Families can receive up to 150 diapers per month per child.
- Once enrolled in the diaper program pilot, you can also receive help with emergency financial assistance, utility assistance, rental or mortgage assistance, food and nutrition programs, child care, and housing and homeless assistance.

## How do I get diapers?

You may be eligible if your monthly income or family size is below these limits and if you can prove guardianship for the child or children who you wish to enroll in the program.
