CSBG Disaster Relief Supplemental Funds Allotment Table

The Additional Supplemental Appropriations for the **Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2023** (Public Law No: 117-328) provided \$25 million in additional funds to the Community Services Block Grant (CSBG) program to address disaster recovery due to the consequences of Hurricanes Fiona in in those areas for which a Presidential disaster has been declared in calendar year 2022. Current eligible states include Puerto Rico (Fiona) and Florida and South Carolina¹ (Ian).

The Office of Community Services (OCS) will allocate funds to grant recipients using a formula that is based on two factors: 1) Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Individual Assistance (IA) data which lists the number of households that have registered for IA assistance and provides a common comparative data point for all grant recipient, and 2) a county-by-county “weighting” based on the median incomes in the county compared to the national average. Each grant recipient will be eligible for a proportionate share of \$25 million based on these factors.

Funds are released in three phases:

- Grant recipients with a total proportionate share of less than \$500K applied for and received their full available amount in **Phase 1**. All remaining grant recipients received \$500K to be used for planning and start-up activities.
- Grant recipients with a total proportionate share of more than \$500K applied for and receive additional funds in **Phase 2** with a cumulative total of approximately \$12.5 million.
- Grant recipients with a proportionate share of more than \$500K may apply for all remaining funds in **Phase 3** and must fully expend all funds by September 30, 2027.

¹ South Carolina declined to apply for funds and was removed from the allotment table.
