The purpose of this communication is to remind the Office of Community Services' grantees and stakeholders about the Administration for Children and Families' (ACF) national convening on the American Rescue Plan Act (ARP) that will take place on Tuesday, August 3, 2021 at 1:00 P.M. - 3:30 P.M. FT.

President Joe Biden signed the ARP into law on March 11, 2021, investing more than \$47.5 billion into seven critical and essential ACF programmatic areas. These federal funds represent one of the most historic investments in the safety, health, and wellbeing of children and families in American history.
