The Office of Community Services (OCS) is proud to celebrate **World Water Day**, an international observance celebrated annually on March 22. World Water Day draws attention to the importance of clean water and sanitation, and raises awareness of the 2 billion people around the world living without access to safe water. Water is critically important for the health and well-being of our families and our communities, and especially for low-income households who are fighting every day to make ends meet.

To celebrate World Water Day, OCS is highlighting two key programs that help maintain affordable, safe and reliable water and wastewater services: The Low Income Household Water Assistance Program (LIHWAP) and the Rural Community Development (RCD) program.

- LIHWAP provides funds to assist low-income households with water and wastewater services. The program also prioritizes restoring services for households that have been disconnected, preventing disconnection, and reducing rates for households that need help paying their bills.
- The RCD program builds community capacity for creating and maintaining safe and affordable water and wastewater systems for the nation's unincorporated areas and lowest-income communities. For additional information about some of RCD's active projects, please visit the RCD Grant Awards Webpage.
