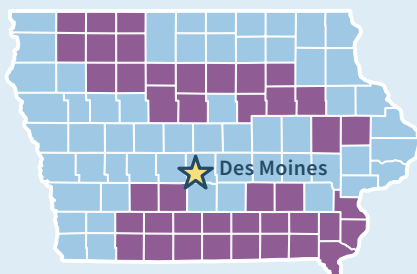


How to Enroll in Your Local Diaper Distribution Pilot Program

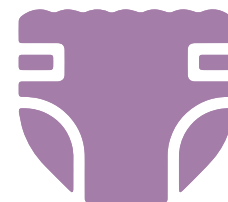
How can ICAA help my family?

- Families can receive diapers every month.
- Once enrolled in the diaper program pilot, you can also receive help with home visitation, LIHEAP, weatherization, Early Head Start and Head Start, employment services, and WIC.

How do I get diapers?

You may be eligible if you are currently enrolled in one of these programs: Family Development and Self-Sufficiency (FaDSS), Early Head Start home visitation, or Parents as Teachers.
