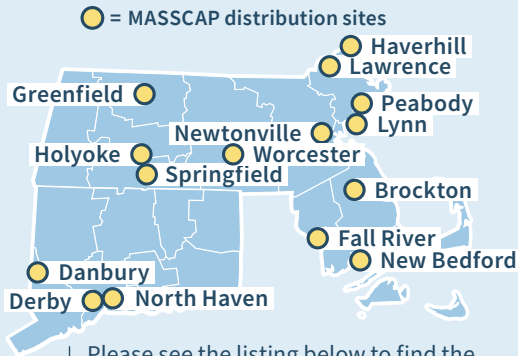

6	\$83,920	\$6,993
7	\$94,680	\$7,890
8	\$105,440	\$8,787
Each Add'l	\$10,760	\$897
