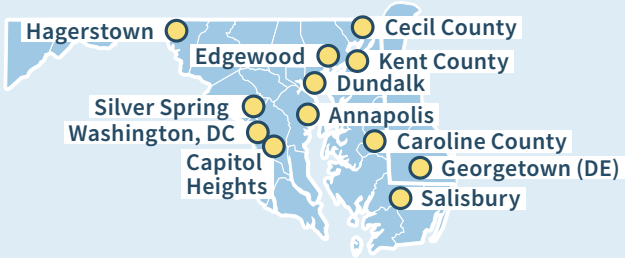


How to Enroll in Your Local Diaper Distribution Pilot Program

How can MCAP help my family?

- Families can receive diapers every other month.
- Once enrolled in the diaper program pilot, you may also receive help with home visitation, LIHEAP, weatherization, Early Head Start and Head Start, employment services, WIC, and more.

How do I receive diapers?

Anne Arundel County Community Action Agency

► **Call 410-626-1900** | Pickup in Annapolis, MD

May be eligible if: At or below 80% of AMI; enroll in Early Head Start for access and receive internal agency referral or partner referral

Community Assistance Network (CAN)

► **Call 410-285-4674** | Pickup in Dundalk, MD

May be eligible if: 150% of FPL; shop in Community Choice Pantry or contact Outreach Department for access

Harford Community Action Agency

► **Call 410-612-9899** | Pickup in Edgewood, MD

May be eligible if 200% of FPL; enroll in one of HCAA's other programs - food pantry, SNAP, energy assistance, homelessness services

Montgomery County Community Action Agency

► **Call 240-777-1866** | Pickup in Silver Spring, MD

May be eligible if: 200% of FPL, enroll in TESS Center, must be enrolled in SNAP, TCA, Medicaid, or qualifying County benefit program.

Maryland Rural Development Corporation (MRDC)

► **Call 410-482-2585** | Delivery to partner schools throughout Cecil, Kent, Caroline Counties, MD

May be eligible if: 125% of FPL; participate in other MRDC programs or partnerships - Head Start, etc.

Shore Up!

► **Call 410-749-1142 x1060** | Pickup in Salisbury, MD

May be eligible if: 200% of FPL; enroll in Early Head Start or Head Start for access

Southern MD Tri-County Community Action Committee

► **Call 301-274-4474** | Pickup in Huntingtown, MD

May be eligible if: 200% of FPL; enroll in Early Head Start or Head Start for access

United Communities Against Poverty (UCAP)

► **Call 301-322-5700 x127** | Pickup in Capitol Heights, MD

May be eligible if: 200% of FPL; enroll in other UCAP programs for access - 2Gen, Homelessness Solutions, Food Pantry, etc

Washington County Community Action Council

► **Call 301-797-4161** | Pickup in Hagerstown, MD, some delivery through partner agencies

May be eligible if 200% of FPL; enroll in other partner programs for access - Hub, Judy Center, SNAP/WIC/MCHIP/TCA/Medicaid application assistance, etc

To enroll in Delaware:

First State Community Action Agency

► **Call 302-295-3557 x144** | Pickup in Georgetown, DE

May be eligible if: 200% of FPL; enroll in one of First State's other programs - food pantry, after school program, emergency services, etc.

To enroll in Washington, DC:

United Planning Organization (UPO)

► **Call 202-238-4600** | Pickup in Wards 5, 6, 7, 8 in Washington, DC

May be eligible if: 200% of FPL; enroll in other UPO programs for access - Job training, Housing Assistance, Financial Management, SNAP application assistance, etc. Families residing in UPO community impact zones can apply through their Impact Zone Facilitator.
