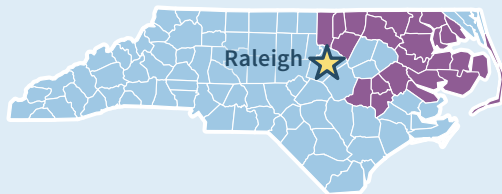


# How to Enroll in Your Local Diaper Distribution Pilot Program

■ = counties served by NCCAA



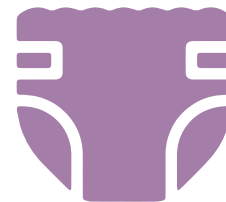

## How can NCCAA help my family?

- Families on the Head Start and Early Head Start waitlist are eligible to receive at least 100 diapers per month, as well as wipes and ointment.
- Once enrolled in the diaper program pilot, you can also receive help with transportation assistance, child-care assistance, parenting classes, food assistance and nutrition support, financial literacy training and other educational supports, self-sufficiency support, first-time homebuyers program enrollment, and referral services.

## How do I get diapers?

- If you are currently on the Head Start or Early Head Start waitlist and in a participating county, then reach out to the closest diaper distribution location for more information:
