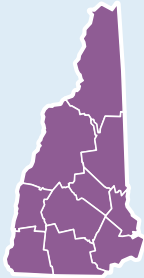

■ = counties served by CAPNH



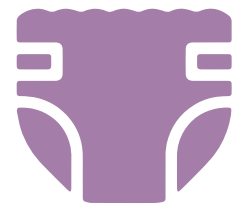
