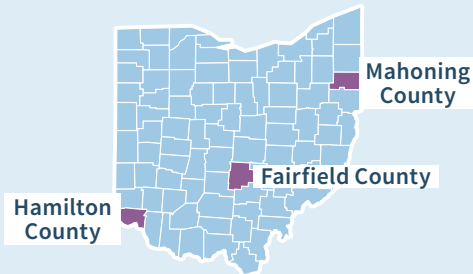


How to Enroll in Your Local Diaper Distribution Pilot Program

How can OCATO help my family?

- Families can receive diapers every month.
- Once enrolled in the diaper program pilot, you can also receive help with home visitation, LIHEAP, weatherization, Early Head Start and Head Start, employment services, and WIC.

How do I receive diapers?

Families are able to pick up diapers at the following locations:

Cincinnati-Hamilton Community Action Agency

Locations: 1740 Langdon Farm Rd; 45237 Theodore M. Berry Head Start; 880 W Court Street

Diapers are distributed via drive-up event the 4th week of every month. If families cannot pick up on designated drive-up event days, Monday pick-up is available weekly from 2-4pm.

Photo ID is required for pick-up.

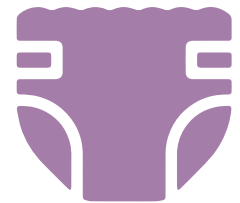
Lancaster-Fairfield Community Action Agency

Location: 1743 E Main Street

Distributed by appointment. **Call our main office at 740-653-4146** to set up an appointment with the case manager.

Must complete a 1-hour intake to receive diapers.

Mahoning-Youngstown Community Action Partnership



Locations: 1325 Fifth Ave.

Youngstown. If delivery is necessary due to lack of transportation, can deliver to any location within Mahoning County.

Clients are scheduled for an initial intake appointment. Monthly distribution is 30 days after intake. Clients are given a return appointment that best fits their schedule. **Call 330-747-7921 Ext. 1766** to schedule intake appointment or reschedule pick-up appointment.

At initial appointment, please bring photo ID, proof of income, and social security card for all household members over 18. For monthly reoccurring appointments, please bring photo ID for the household member that is completing the follow-up survey and picking up diapers.
