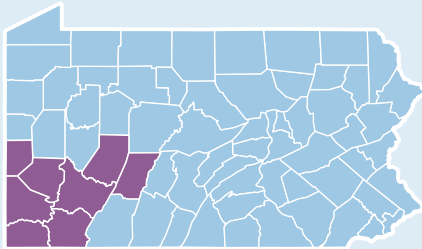


# How to Enroll in Your Local Diaper Distribution Pilot Program
