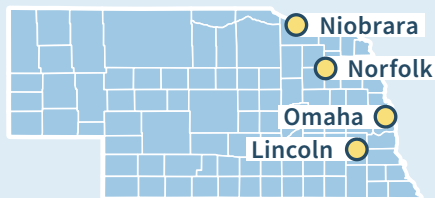


How to Enroll in Your Local Diaper Distribution Pilot Program

● = locations of PTN offices



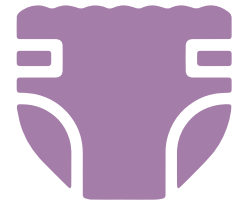
How can PTN help my family?

- Families can receive diapers every month.
- Once enrolled in the diaper program pilot, you can also receive help with home visitation, LIHEAP, weatherization, Early Head Start and Head Start, employment services, and WIC.

How do I get diapers?

The Ponca Tribe of Nebraska operates within a designated service area covering fifteen counties in Nebraska, South Dakota, and Iowa. The Tribe has office sites located in five of these counties. In Nebraska, PTN offices are established in Niobrara, Norfolk, Lincoln, and Omaha.
