# Low Income Household Water Assistance Program

NORTHERN CHEYENNE LIHWAP PROFILE SUMMARY



The Northern Cheyenne Tribe's Low Income Household Water Assistance Program (LIHWAP) is funded at \$185,203 in FY21. The Northern Cheyenne utilizes LIHWAP grant funds to restore water and wastewater services for households with arrearages.

# **Program Operation**

The Northern Cheyenne Tribe's LIHWAP, which began in May 2022, is centrally administered by the Tribe in coordination with other programs available to low-income households. The Northern Cheyenne's LIHWAP provides relief assistance to **two priority groups**:

- Households without water and wastewater services due to nonpayment of arrearages
- Households that need their septic tanks pumped

Tribal staff conduct outreach activities, determine client eligibility, and process benefit payments to water service providers.



- Coordination with the Food Distribution coordinator
- One-stop intake through LIHEAP

# **Use of Funding by Funding Source**



### **Benefits on Behalf of Households**

Under the Tribe's administration of the program, eligible households may receive a one-time benefit assistance of up to \$1,100.

# **Priority Populations**

Households that meet program eligibility criteria **and** fall in one of the following categories receive priority assistance.

- ✓ People with disabilities
- √ Families with young children
- ✓ Older Adult/Seniors (60+)
- ✓ Households with high water burden

### **Program Outreach Activities**

- Work directly with water utilities to identify potential recipients.
- Inclusion of inserts in water vendor billings to inform individuals of the availability of LIHWAP assistance.
- Mass mailing(s) to prior-year LIHEAP recipients or recipients of other government benefits.
- Place posters/flyers in all local businesses, and public places.
