Low Income Household Water Assistance Program

SITKA TRIBE OF ALASKA LIHWAP PROFILE SUMMARY



The Sitka Tribe's Low Income Household Water Assistance Program (LIHWAP) is funded at \$94,461 in FY21. The Tribe utilizes LIHWAP grant funds to provide emergency assistance to enable low-income households to access water and wastewater services.

Program Operation

The Sitka Tribe's LIHWAP, which began in April 2022, is managed and operated at the Tribal level in coordination with other programs available to low-income households. The Sitka Tribe's LIHWAP provides relief assistance to **three priority groups**:

- Households without current water services
- Households that require clean water when pipes freeze
- Households that require financial assistance to pay the fees required to unfreeze pipes

Program staff conduct outreach activities, determine client eligibility, and process benefit payments for water service providers.



PROGRAM COORDINATION

 One application for LIHEAP and LIHWAP and streamlined intake process to determine program eligibility without requiring multiple applications.





Benefits on Behalf of Households

Under the Tribe's administration of the program, eligible households may receive up to \$1,625 in benefits.

Priority Populations

Households that meet program eligibility criteria and fall in one of the following categories receive priority and their applications are processed two weeks of receipt.

- ✓ People with disabilities
- √ Families with young children
- ✓ Older Adult/Seniors (60+)

Applications from all other households, including households with high water burden, are processed within 30 days.

Program Outreach Activities

- Place posters/flyers in local and county social service offices, offices of aging, Social Security offices, Veterans Affairs, etc.
- Publication of articles or public service announcements in local newspapers or broadcast media announcements.
- Work directly with water utilities to identify potential recipients.
- Mass mailing(s) to prior-year LIHEAP recipients or recipients of other government benefits.
- Automated phone campaigns and/or social media outreach.
- Inform low-income applicants of the availability of all types of LIHWAP assistance at application intake for other low-income programs.
