The Village of Aniak Low Income Household Water
Assistance Program (LIHWAP) is funded at \$18,707 in
FY21. The Village of Aniak utilizes LIHWAP grant funds to
provide emergency assistance to enable low-income
households to access water and wastewater services.

Program Operation

The Village of Aniak's LIHWAP, which began in January 2022, is managed and operated at Tribal level in coordination with other programs available to low-income households. The Village of Aniak's LIHWAP prioritizes relief assistance to households with passed due water and sewer bills.

Program staff determine client eligibility and process benefit payments to water service providers.




Payment of arrearages

Benefits on Behalf of Households

Under the Tribe's administration of the program, eligible households may receive a one-time benefit of up to \$210. Program staff use a benefit matrix to determine eligibility amounts and prioritize assistance.

Priority Populations

Households that meet program eligibility criteria and fall in one of the following categories receive priority assistance.

- √ People with disabilities
- √ Families with young children
- ✓ Older Adult/Seniors (60+)
- ✓ Households with high water burden

Customers in single family households are put on a list for assistance after the most vulnerable populations are served, and based on available funding.

Program Outreach Activities

- Work directly with water utilities to identify potential recipients.
- Inform low-income applicants of the availability of all types of LIHWAP assistance at application intake for other low-income programs.
- Post flyers throughout the community including at the local store and post office.
