■ = areas served by SPIPA



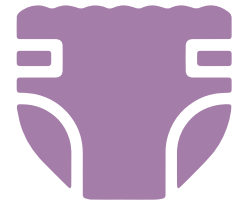

How can SPIPA help my family?


- Families can receive up to one case of diapers per child, per month for home and 50 diapers per child, per month for child care.
- Once enrolled in the diaper program pilot, you can also receive help with child care, employment training, cash assistance, utility assistance, food assistance, and WIC.

How do I get diapers?

- You are eligible if you are an enrolled tribal member living on or near the reservation communities of **Chehalis, Nisqually, Shoalwater Bay, Skokomish, Squaxin Island, or Port Gamble S'Klallam.**
