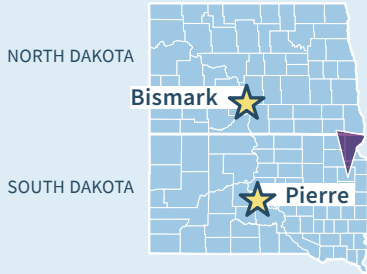


How to Enroll in Your Local Diaper Distribution Pilot Program

How can SWO help my family?

- Families can receive one box of diapers and 2 packs of wipes per month per child. Diaper rash cream, cloth diapers, and more resources are also available.
- Once enrolled in the diaper program pilot, participants can find information on current or upcoming services in the community and throughout the tribe.

How do I receive diapers?

Any Native child on the Lake Traverse Reservation is eligible.

- Visit the office or call a staff member to complete an intake form. Please have the child's parent/guardian contact information, date of birth, and diaper size available on intake.

- There are two all-day distribution events each month at designated locations. Excluding distribution event days, participants may pick up at the diaper distribution office Monday through Wednesday 8:30 am - 4:00 pm. Staff are available to deliver diapers upon request for those without reliable transportation or who are unable to make it to the distribution events or office. The Distribution Office is located at the SWO Administration Building.

- You can pick up diapers in the office on certain days. There are also distribution events twice a month in different locations and delivery is available upon request.
