The supervisor survey instrument is the nearly the same as the home visitor survey instrument. The following list describes areas of difference.

Section B	 Employment and Supervision Same as home visitor survey except as follows: 1) Items 3, 5, and 6 are modified to reflect supervisor activities and caseloads; 2) Item 9 is modified to reflect supervision of staff rather than direct service; 3) Items 13-15 are modified to reflect supervision of the supervisor; 4) Items 16a – 16c and 20 – 21 are omitted.
Section C	 Psychological Well-being Same as home visitor survey
Section D	 Organizational Social Context Same as home visitor survey
Section E	 Program Outcomes Same as home visitor survey
Section F	 Program Referrals Section is omitted
Sections G-N	 Home Visitor Roles and Responsibilities Section i of G-N is the same as home visitor survey except that column headings are modified to reflect the supervisor's belief that activities are essential for the home visitor's role; the supervisor rates her own training as excellent for supervising staff in carrying out the activities; and the supervisor believes she is highly skilled to supervise staff in carrying out the activities. Section ii of G-N is modified to reflect the supervisor's ratings of her own ability to secure supervision and professional consultation in each area.
