



## Trafficking Victims Assistance Program, FY 2019

In FY 2019, the Office on Trafficking in Persons (OTIP) provided **\$10,862,550** in grant funding for the Trafficking Victim Assistance Program (TVAP), to provide comprehensive case management services to foreign national victims of human trafficking seeking HHS Certification and their qualified family members through a national network of service providers.

TVAP grantees served program participants from more than 80 countries in FY 2019, with 55% of clients from Mexico, Honduras, or the Philippines.

In FY 2019, 82 TVAP-funded service providers assisted 1,573 victims of trafficking and qualified family members in 48 states and U.S. territories.

### SERVICES PROVIDED IN FY 2019



720 clients accessed housing costing \$382,637.



524 clients accessed clothing costing \$37,554.



690 clients accessed food costing \$177,839.



496 clients accessed transportation costing \$52,677.



673 clients accessed gift cards costing \$18,731.



409 clients accessed medical services costing \$3,870.



614 clients accessed personal care items costing \$69,226.



395 clients accessed language services costing \$1,342.

Housing was the highest cost need for survivors of trafficking and qualified family members in FY 2019.
