Grant Goals

Program Goals The goal of the Zaagichigaazowin Home Visiting (ZHV) program is to provide culturally relevant, medically accurate, developmentally appropriate pre-conception, childbearing, and postpartum home visiting services within the Red Cliff Band of Lake Superior Ojibwe early childhood service delivery system.

Location of Community	Rural Reservation
Population Served	The Zaagichigaazowin Home Visiting Program serves families who live on or within 15 miles of the Red Cliff Band of Lake Superior Ojibwe Reservation. At least one primary caregiver must be a tribal member or eligible for tribal membership in order to be eligible for the Zaagichigaazowin Home Visiting Program services.
Model	Parents as Teachers (PAT)
Program Components and Other Adjustments	The ZHV program uses cultural teachings and activities as the foundation and structure of the program with an aim to increase participation of fathers and extended family members in all aspects of service delivery, and to increase preconception/adolescent knowledge and health related to sexuality and healthy lifestyles. These adaptations and enhancements are provided through Red Cliff's culturally based Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder prevention program, the coming of age and other pertinent ceremonies, and cradleboard-based teachings related to health and relationships. Specific adaptations to the PAT program include using community-based douglas as PAT home visitors and increasing prenatal home visiting intensity.

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
