FY2015 Family Violence Prevention & Services Act Awards to States and Territories

The Family Violence Prevention & Services Program in the Family Youth & Services Bureau administers the Family Violence Prevention & Services Act (FVPSA) funding, the only source of dedicated funding for domestic violence shelter and supportive services since 1984. In FY2015, the appropriation for FVPSA was \$135 million.

In FY2015, State and Territorial Formula Grants Program received \$94.5 million or 70% of FVPSA funds. We have provided the amounts by state and Territory below.
