STATE HIGHLIGHTS

- In 2012, the Oregon Legislature passed legislation establishing the Early Learning Council as the single body charged with guiding early learning and development programs.
- In 2012, legislation directed the Early Learning Council and Department of Education to develop a Kindergarten Readiness Assessment.
- In the first year of Oregon's Quality Rating Improvement System (QRIS) field test, 4,326 providers participated, serving 35,263 children in 2 Star programs or above.
- Oregon's online professional development registry provides workforce data on 100% of practitioners in regulated facilities.
- The Oregon Education Investment Board adopted an Equity Lens to guide policy recommendations and community engagement.





