CED Funding Updates

- Two Upcoming Funding Opportunities
 - CED
 - CED-HFFI
- **Applications Due April 27, 2016**
- All awards will be made by September 30, 2016
- Some minor changes from last year
- Applicants may not receive awards under both announcements



CED Funding Summary

- Support businesses that develop new products, services, and other commercial activities that result in the creation of new positions for low-income individuals
- Funding: \$17,700,000
- Expected Number of Awards: 22
- Award Ceiling: \$800,000
- Award Floor: \$100,000



CED-HFFI Funding Summary

- Provide technical and financial assistance for healthy food ventures designed to:
 - Improve access to, and purchase and consumption of healthy, affordable foods; AND
 - Address the economic needs of low-income individuals and families through the creation of employment and business opportunities in low-income communities.
- Funding: \$9,500,000
- Expected Number of Awards: 13
- Award Ceiling: \$800,000
- Award Floor: \$100,000



Bonus Points

- Projects in States/Territories w/out a current project
- Projects in Counties with Persistent Poverty
- Alignment with Promise Zones Initiative or Choice Neighborhoods Program
- *For CED-HFFI ONLY:* Collaboration with other HFFI Programs



All Projects Must...

- Be ready to implement at the time of award
- Lead to increased self-sufficiency for low-income individuals and their families
- Create businesses and jobs in low-income communities
- Attracts additional public and private funds to increase investment

Assets for Independence (AFI) Program

AFI supports asset building projects that feature Individual Development Accounts (IDAs), financial education, and related services.

2016 Funding Opportunity Announcement (FOA) Due Dates:

- FY 2014: 05/07/2014 and 07/14/2014
- FY 2015: 10/25/2014 and 04/20/2015
- FY 2016: 12/15/2015 and 05/13/2016

NOTE: The FOA contains changes from previous announcements, such as:

- All applicants must comply with ACF's new Two-File Submission Requirement.
- Additional documentation requirements for non-federal cash commitments.
- Full description of the applicant organization's fiscal control and accountability procedures.

Eligible AFI applicants:

- 501(c)(3) nonprofit entities
- State, local, and tribal government agencies
- Community Development Financial Institutions
- Low-income credit unions
- Consortia of organizations and agencies

You Need to Know:

- Grantees must have non-federal cash commitment at least equal to the federal grant amount.
- Grantees must expend at least 85% of federal and non-federal funding to match participant IDA savings.
- Grantees may expend the remaining 15% on administrative costs, as prescribed by the AFI Act.
