The purpose of this message is to provide you with an update on the fourth quarter Social Services Block Grant (SSBG) allocations for fiscal year (FY) 2016. These awards represent the fourth release of funding to date for FY 2016.

As noted in prior correspondence, Congress appropriated these funds under the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2016 (Public law 114-113), which provided the final budget for FY 2016 and which the President signed into law on December 18, 2015. The fourth quarter funds for FY 2016 SSBG allotment is being released to all States and Territories for expenditures made available in accordance with the State's plan under title XX of the Social Security Act. For planning purposes, a chart is attached to show the full amounts allocated for FY 2016, as well as the first, second, and third quarter amounts released for each State.

Thank you for your continued partnership and cooperation with the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) and Administration for Children and Families (ACF) as we work together to continue providing quality service to vulnerable individuals, children and families.
