# Enhancing Partnerships with TANF

- Semi-structured interviews with 6 HPOG grantees and their TANF partners.
- Grantees interviewed either are meeting or are close to meeting their TANF participation rate and/or have a unique approach/promising practice.

# Enhancing Partnerships with TANF: Lessons Learned

Building strong collaborations with TANF agencies:

- Include TANF partners early.
- Establish formal agreements.
- Align service approaches between HPOG & TANF.
- Co-locate services.
- Share success stories.

# Enhancing Partnerships with TANF: Lessons Learned

Better engaging TANF participants:

- Create structured identification and referral processes.
- Provide intensive case management supports.
- Address TANF work participation requirements.
