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# **1. UNIQUE LIEN ADDRESS FOR ISO COMPANIES (OCSE REF. # 4957)**

## **1.1 Summary of Changes**

We enhanced the Insurance Match (IM) system to replace the address the Insurance Services Office (ISO) reports with the lien address the insurance company submits.

## **1.2 Background**

Some insurance companies requested that states send child support withholding notices and liens to an address different from the address ISO sent. Prior to this change, states used a spreadsheet to track lien addresses.

## **1.3 Description of Changes**

This enhancement overlays the insurer address fields on the IM response record received from ISO with the lien address the insurance company supplies. We notified states of this change via e-Flash # 14-05, and put this change into production on June 9, 2014.

## **1.4 Impact on States**

States do not need to change their systems to take advantage of this enhancement.

## **1.5 State Testing**

Testing is not required for this enhancement.

This enhancement did not result in changes to output records.

## **2. ADD NEW CLAIM TYPES (OCSE REF. # 5131)**

### **2.1 Summary of Changes**

We are enhancing the IM system to add new claim type code values to the IM response record. We are also assigning a value of '99' to the 'Other' claim type code. The previous value for the 'Other' claim type code was '12.'

### **2.2 Background**

Currently the IM system does not process claims for disability, annuities, policy surrender, mutual funds, or unemployment.

### **2.3 Description of Changes**

We are adding or changing the following values for Insurance Product Claim Type codes, positions 471-472 of the Part 1 record:

- 12 – Property damage (see note below)
- 14 – Disability
- 15 – Annuity
- 16 – Policy surrender
- 17 – Mutual fund
- 18 – Unemployment
- 19 – Dividend withdrawals
- 99 – Other

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**Note:** We currently send property damage claims to Texas in accordance with Texas regulations. If other states adopt similar regulations, we could also send them property damage claims.

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### **2.4 Impact on States**

You may need to program for these new code values depending on your system's design.

The full list of values for this field (Insurance Product Claim Type) is:

- 00 – Life
- 01 – Automobile
- 02 – Automobile – No fault
- 03 – Automobile – Medical
- 04 – Property liability
- 05 – Workers' compensation
- 06 – Personal injury
- 07 – General liability
- 08 – Homeowners liability
- 09 – Medical premise/Owners policy

- 10 – Product liability
- 11 – Slip, trip, and fall
- 12 – Property damage
- 13 – Unknown
- 14 – Disability
- 15 – Annuity
- 16 – Policy surrender
- 17 – Mutual fund
- 18 – Unemployment
- 19 – Dividend withdrawals
- 99 – Other
