Not My Life is the first film to depict the cruel and dehumanizing practices of human trafficking and modern slavery on a global scale.

- Filmed on five continents, in a dozen countries, Not My Life takes viewers into a world where millions of children are exploited, every day, through an astonishing array of practices including forced labor, domestic servitude, begging, sex tourism, sexual violence, and child soldiering.
- Not My Life's message is ultimately one of hope. Victims of slavery can be set free and go on to live happy and productive lives. Those who advocate for slavery victims are growing in numbers, and are increasingly effective.

RESTORE NYC's mission is to end sex trafficking in New York and restore the well-being and independence of foreign national survivors. Working to this end, they:

- Find victims through their outreach strategies and partnerships with law enforcement, the court system, and community-based organizations.
- Restore survivors through their groundbreaking safehome program.

JIMMY LEE, EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Prior to joining Restore as Executive Director in April 2012, Jimmy Lee was the Vice President of Strategy and Regional Affairs for GBCHealth where he led strategy development and managed offices in Johannesburg, Beijing, Nairobi, Kiev, Paris and Moscow. Before that, Jimmy was Director of Strategic Planning & Business Analysis at American Express, Director of Strategic Initiatives at World Vision, an investment banker at J.P. Morgan and a financial analyst at Goldman, Sachs.

Jimmy joined the board of directors of Restore in 2008 and was the Chairman of the Board until early 2011. During his leadership on the board, the organization launched its outreach strategy and opened the first safehome of its kind in the northeastern United States.
